Can you commit to the dates? 7 full days for 3 credit and 14 full days for 5 credit. Attendance (ie. daily online activity) is mandatory! No lates. No leaving early. No absences.

Attendance Requirements – What is expected of you?

**Full attendance in Summer School courses is mandatory. Each "day" of Summer School is the equivalent of one week of class during the regular semester. Due to the already abbreviated and rigorous nature of Summer School courses, no provisions will be made for missed classes, or for the late start or early release of the student due to holiday plans, sporting camps, doctor, dental, job interviews etc. Students are expected to attend every class as scheduled and to be present on the last day of class to write the final. Final exams will not be rescheduled. If you cannot commit to Summer School calendar, please do not register as refunds will not be given.

Term 1: Monday, July 5 - Tuesday, July 13 (3 credit courses) 8:30 am - 4:00 pm

Term 2: Wednesday, July 14 - Thursday, July 22 (3 credit courses) 8:30 am - 4:00 pm

5 credit courses - both terms: Monday, July 5 to Thursday, July 22, 8:30 am - 4:00 pm

Summer School Course Fees

1 credit courses - \$10

3 credit courses - \$40

5 credit courses - \$70

Math 10C Prep "Competencies in Math" - \$70

* Courses will run only with sufficient enrollment.

Inclusive Learning Supports

Please note that because Summer School is not a mandatory program, and is a program of choice, due to the accelerated nature of instruction, fast pace, and longer school days, there are no *Educational Assistant Supports* put in place for Summer School. If you have an Individual Support Plan (ISP), please contact the Collaborative Response Coordinator at your school to assist in determining if general classroom accommodations and a quicker pace of instruction match the recommendations for success set out in your ISP.

Registration & Payment

- All registrations must be completed using the EICS PowerSchool Parent
 Portal. All fees will be posted there and must be paid prior to June 1, 2021.
 There will be no changes made to student timetables after June 29, 2021.
 Registrations will be locked.
- Students wishing to register for a course, and if FULL, will be placed on the waitlist in the order in which the registration was received. The Principal will contact you if a spot opens up. Please note: You cannot be put on a waitlist and be registered in a different course concurrently; PowerSchool cannot dual enroll. If you are on a waitlist for a course in Term 1 and then choose to register in a different course in Term 1, you will have been dropped from the waitlist.
- **IMPORTANT: EICS reserves the right to cancel a course(s) due to low enrollment. If this is the case, a full refund will be issued.

Religion at EICS Summer School

Elk Island Catholic Schools has determined, after much consideration, that Summer School Religion classes do not reflect nor aid in our mission as a provider of Catholic Education. For that reason, **EICS Summer School will no longer offer Religious Studies.** We regret if this causes any inconvenience or disappointment, but invite you to consider the breadth of other course offerings which can similarly serve as a means of working toward a well rounded education.

We have 2 Delivery Modes:

- In-Person Learning: Phys Ed Only (note: Phys Ed could switch to online, based on the provincial Covid situation. <u>Site:</u> Archbishop Jordan (Sherwood Park) Term 1 & 2
- Online Courses: Term 1 & 2.

*Phys Ed: <u>if in-person</u>, we follow the term schedule strictly, with students attending physically, according to our traditional 8:30 am bell schedule.

Please Note: Due to Covid constraints, Parents can not enter the building. Students must bring their own lunches as <u>drop offs will not be allowed</u>.

*Online Terms: Parents will register students in either a Term 1 course, Term 2, or both according to the schedule (to reflect powerschool structures). However, students will have access to all their courses for the entire 3 weeks.

<u>In-Person Phys Ed: ABJ Campus (July 5- July 22):</u>

Term 1: Phys Ed 10/20: 3 sections of 20 (due to limited space) Term 2: Phys Ed 10/20 3 sections of 20 (due to limited space)


Online Learning Courses: (July 5- July 22):

- * Students may take one or two 3-Credit courses, or they may take one 5-Credit Course. Courses will run <u>only</u> with sufficient enrollment.
 - HCS3000 Workplace Safety Systems (1 Credit) Cost is \$10
 - HCS3010 Workplace Safety Practices (1 Credit) (HCS3000 is the prereg) Cost is \$10
 - AGR 3000- Agriculture Safety Practices (1 Credit) Cost is \$10

 - Forensics 25 -(Pre-requisite is completion of a Grade 10 Science Course) (3 Credits)
 - Forensics 35 (Pre-requisite is Forensics 25) (3 Credits)
 - Science 10 (5 Credits)
 - Science 14 (5 Credits)
 - Science 24 (5 Credits)
 - Science 20 (5 Credits)
 - Biology 20 (5 Credits)
 - Chemistry 20 (5 Credits)

 - Social 20-1/20-2 (5 Credits)

Online Diploma Classes:

*We will only run a diploma course if there is sufficient enrollment. Additionally, due to the voluntary nature of Diploma Exams this year, we will **not** be hosting diploma exams. Students who wish to write the Diploma Exam will be responsible for booking their own sitting at a <u>Provincial Writing Center</u>.
